



National Coordinator of Ricochet Terms of Reference

1. **Authority for Appointment.** The Croquet Australia National Coordinator of Ricochet (NCRC) is authorised by the Board to carry out the undermentioned responsibilities and functions on behalf of the Board.
2. **Appointment** NCRC is appointed by the Board for a period of two years at the Board meeting following the AGM. In the case of a casual vacancy, a person may be appointed to fill the remainder of the term of that appointment.
3. **Responsibilities.** The National Coordinator of Ricochet shall:
 - 3.1. Develop and promote the game of Ricochet in coordination with the State Directors/Coordinators of Ricochet or the person/s fulfilling that function.
 - 3.2. Act as the National Coordinator of Ricochet Referees until such position is filled in its own right. The duties and responsibilities of are contained in the National Coordinators of Referees Terms of Reference, available from the Croquet Australia website
4. **Management**
 - 4.1. The NCRC is responsible to the Board and accountable for all decisions made and actions taken in the performance of their duties.
 - 4.2. The NCRC shall provide reports to the Board as requested and shall, in any case, provide a report for inclusion in the Croquet Australia Annual Report.
