



Australian Golf Croquet – Open Singles

- How to Enter:** via the ACA website at: <https://croquet-australia.com.au/gc-open-singles/>
Complete the new on-line entry, and keep an eye on Entries in croquetscores.
- Closing Date for Entries:** **Thursday 29 April** (midnight WA time)
- Entry Fees:** \$142 per player
If entering the Plate ONLY: \$71 per player
Full time students (under 25) and players aged under 21 at 31 December 2021 are entitled to 50% reduction of the above fees.
- Functions:** No formal functions have been arranged but there will be a presentation at the conclusion of the final.
- Prizes:** The Winner receives an ACA gold medal and the Tony Hall Cup; Runner Up receives an ACA silver medal; and certificates are awarded for Third, Fourth and the winners of W, Z, Y and Plate.
- Draw:** To be conducted by the ACA Tournament, Events and GC Selection Committees using the ACA Seeding and Draw procedures. The latest available world GC ranking list current will be used for seeding purposes
- Registration:** From 2pm Tuesday 11 May or before play on Wednesday 12 May. You could time your registration to coincide with the presentation after the Open Doubles.
- Format:** Block play with single games then 16 players into knockout, or other format, depending on entries. Finals matches will be best of 3, 13 point games, except the final which will be best of 5 if time permits. Quarter-Final losers will play-off for 5--8th places and Semi-Final losers will play-off for 3rd/4th place. All games will start without time-limits.
Players not making the finals proceed to the Plate which is designed to maximise the amount of play and will be conducted as large blocks or Swiss, with a single life knockout final. Players may enter direct without playing in the main event but please complete an entry form.
