



## Rescheduling/Cancellation of Events Policy

### Background

There are times, especially during epidemics/pandemics or natural disasters, when programmed tournaments of events will require to be either rescheduled or cancelled. This policy defines the procedures for such rescheduling or cancellation.

### Authority

This policy is made under the provisions of the Australian Croquet Association Inc Constitution, s29.

### Policy

If circumstances indicate that it is likely that an Australian Croquet Association tournament or event may require to be rescheduled or cancelled, the Events Committee is to review the need to reschedule or cancel the tournament or event as late as possible but in sufficient time to advise its decision by six (6) weeks prior to the first day of play in the relevant tournament or event. That decision is to be advised to the Australian Croquet Association Executive Officer, all participants, and the State Secretaries.

The National Coordinator Gateball is to advise the Events Committee of any likelihood of a Gateball tournament or event needing to be rescheduled or cancelled, together with their recommendation, in sufficient time for the above procedure to be followed.

At each stage, the Australian Croquet Association Executive Officer is to post an appropriate news item to the Australian Croquet Association website,
