

Board Chairperson Position Description

Introduction

- 1. The Croquet Australia Board appoints its Chairperson from amongst its members and the Chairperson serves in that position for the remainder of their current two year term and are eligible to be reappointed as Chairperson if they are re-elected to the Board at the completion of that term.
- 2. The Chairperson shall be considered to be the principal spokesperson of the Board and of Croquet Australia

Chairperson's Responsibilities

- 3. The Chairperson will normally chair all meetings of the Board and of Croquet Australia.
- 4. The chair does not have a casting vote at such meetings
- 5. The responsibilities of Board Directors, as contained in the Board Directors' Position Description (13th February 2020) also apply.
