- Be professional and accept responsibility for your actions.
- Commit to providing quality service to players.
- Operate within the rules and spirit of your croquet.
- Abide by Anti-Doping regulations.
- Seek permission before making physical contact with players.
- Refrain from any form of personal abuse towards players.
- Refrain from any form of harassment towards players.
- Provide a safe environment for training and competition.
- Provide a modified program if applicable.
- Ensure equipment and facilities are safe for use.
- Show concern and caution towards sick and injured players.
- Be a positive role model.
- Seek continual improvement through professional development and performance appraisals.
- Maintain appropriate records.
- Abide by privacy laws, and ensure personal information is securely stored.
