# GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. All events will be played under the Laws of Association Croquet, seventh edition amended 2021, as adopted by Croquet Australia; and the Australian Tournament Regulations, as amended on 15 February 2023, including the WCF Refereeing Regulations.
2. All competitors who have not already provided an address, telephone number or email address at which messages can reach them during the events should provide this information to the Tournament Manager during registration.
3. Tournament Headquarters is the Victorian Croquet Centre (VCC).
4. Courts will be available for practice at VCC from 2–5pm on Friday 15 November at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. Courts may be available for practice from 7:30am to 7.50am each day, and after the completion of play for the day (at the discretion of the Tournament Manager).
5. Atkins Quadway Hoops will be used in all events. As per Croquet Australia Tournament Regulation 15.6.1, hoops will be set as near as possible to:
  - (a) 3+11/16" with an upward tolerance of zero and a downward tolerance of 1/32" for the Doubles & Singles; then
  - (b) largest ball on court plus a clearance of 1/32" for the Knockout stages.
6. Players are requested to assist in setting the hoops at the start of the day if necessary.
7. Any player is entitled to have equipment checked at any time and any hoop out of specification will then be reset. Players should not adjust or hammer hoops themselves.
8. Dawson International balls will be used.
9. Courts will be allocated by the Manager and games will be double banked as required.
10. A 5 minute warm up period will be permitted before a player's first game of the day, when hoops may only be run in a controlled fashion
11. Matches shall commence at **8.00 am** sharp unless otherwise indicated. Players are requested to be at their designated court before the scheduled starting time.
12. Players may be allowed a break of up to 10 minutes between matches and a lunch break of up to 30 minutes. No break is allowed between games of multiple game matches. The Tournament Manager will ensure games go on expeditiously to enable completion of the scheduled program.
13. Players must ask the Venue Manager if they wish to leave the venue for any reason.
14. Players will wear footwear which will not mark the court and provides adequate protection for themselves both on and off the court; and neat, clean attire which the Tournament Manager judges will not cause significant offence to others. A player in unsuitable clothing or footwear will be given the opportunity to dress appropriately or will not be permitted to participate in the event
15. The Tournament Manager decides whether play in any match should continue if the weather is deteriorating.
16. Referees will be Supervising Referees.
17. The Tournament Manager in consultation with the Board of Croquet Australia may make any alterations to the program, draw and other arrangements as are necessary in order to complete the tournament in the time available.
18. Special damage may be repaired in accordance with Law 37.3.
19. Players' attention is drawn to Law 56 regarding Expedition in Play.
20. The Australian Handicapping System is in use for this Tournament. Players must ensure that they have their handicap cards with them and present them to the Tournament Handicapper before the Open Singles. Handicap changes will be effective after any game in which players pass a trigger point (in accordance with the updated Handicapping Regulations published on the Croquet Australia Website on 14 February 2010).

21. An appeals committee comprising the Tournament Manager, the appropriate Tournament Referee and a member of the Croquet Australia Board (or nominated representative) shall determine any matters that are in dispute during the course of the tournament.
22. The draws were conducted by the Croquet Australia Events Committee, in conjunction with the Association Croquet Selection Committee & the Tournament Manager.
23. Should an overseas player win an event, any perpetual trophy shall remain in Australia in the custody of the Croquet Australia National Operations Manager. Winners of trophies are responsible for arranging the engraving of trophies at the Croquet Australia's expense, but must obtain a quote and obtain approval from the Croquet Australia National Operations Manager prior to having a trophy engraved.

## **Australian Open Association Croquet Doubles 2024**

1. One block of, where each pair plays single 26 point games against each of the other pairs, with a time limit of 2½ hours;
2. Four rounds will be played on Day 1 (Saturday 16 November), four rounds on Day 2 (Sunday 17 November) and the ninth round on Day 3 (Monday 18 November).
3. A standard block-based knockout draw will be used.
4. The top 2 pairs (based on matches won, then net hoops, then who beat who) proceed to the Final. There will not be a tiebreaker, even if several pairs have the same match wins.
5. The Final is a best of three with cumulative time limits of 3, 2½ and 2 hours. All games are subject to Regulation 16.
6. The other pairs may proceed to a Doubles Plate on Day 3, played as a Egyptian or Flexible Swiss, depending on the number of pairs and at the Tournament Manager's discretion.

## Australian Open Association Croquet Singles Championships 2024

1. There were not enough entries for a Pre-Drawn Swiss, so format is a single block playing a round robin of single 26 point games.
2. There will be 4 games on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday plus a final games on Friday.
3. The top 8 players will qualify for the XYZW knockout, which will start on Friday. Placings will be by games won, then net hoops, then who beat who - but any players initially placed eighth or worse but on the same wins are to play a single game tiebreaker as a 2<sup>nd</sup> round on Day 4.
4. A block-based knockout draw will be used.
5. The knockout stage will be quarter-finals (bo3 Friday) matches with cumulative time limits of 3, 2½ & 2 hours. The semi-finals (Saturday and final (Sunday) will be bo5 (time permitting) with cumulative time limits of 3, 3, 2½, 2 & 1 ½ hours. All games are subject to Regulation 16.
6. Players exiting the knockout may join the YZW events. These will all be bo3 knockout. There will be a play off for 3rd & 4th.
7. There will also be an Egyptian event available (Swiss format, but not pre-drawn) for all players regardless of whether they qualify or not. This will be running alongside the other events from day 2 onwards and players can play in it when they have free time between games/matches in the other events. All players are encouraged to play in this event so that those who want extra games can get them.

### Singles Plate Event

8. Players who do not proceed to the X knockout are eligible to play in the Plate event, which will start on Day 4 (Friday 22 November). The event will be played as a double round robin, with 3 games on Friday, 4 on Saturday, and 3 games on Sunday - depending on numbers and at the Tournament Manager's discretion.
9. Plate matches will be single games with a time limit of 2½ hours.
10. The AB Morrison Encouragement Award will be awarded to the player with a DGrade of less than 1700 on the World Ranking list at the closing date for entries, who wins the most games played in the Open Singles (including the Plate).
